Christopher Manning is an award-winning writer and director of narrative fiction. He earned a BA in History from Columbia University in the City of New York before studying filmmaking at the London Film School.



Dana Budisavljević is the author and coauthor of several award-winning documentaries, such as *STRAIGHT A'S*, which brought her the Grand Prix at 2005 Croatian Film Days.



Dr Sebastian Kraemer FRCP FRCPsych FRCPCH is consultant child and adolescent psychiatrist at the Whittington Hospital, London, and was director of the Tavistock child and adolescent psychiatry higher training from 1986 to 2001. For five years he was a member of the RCPsych special advisory committee on child and adolescent psychiatry. He was awarded an honorary Doctorate of Education by the University of East London in 2007.



Dr Miomir Milovanovic is Consultant Psychiatrist in Psychotherapy at NEPFT NHS Trust, a psychoanalyst and Honorary Senior Lecturer at the Centre of Psychoanalytic Studies. He works with individual in and out-patients, teams and different professional groups within mental health organizations. He also works in private practice.



Kannan Navaratnem is a member of the British Psychoanalytical Society and a psychoanalyst in private practice. He is editor of the *Bulletin of the British Psychoanalytical Society* and a member of the organising committee of the European Psychoanalytic Film Festival (EPFF).
