- We can confirm that the Trust has not employed any Security staff with an SIA licence over the last five years.
 - It may be helpful to note that The Trust is not a hospital. The Tavistock and Portman NHS Foundation Trust is a specialist Mental Health Trust which provides mainly outpatient psychological services. We do not provide any acute services, nor restraint or admitted patient care
