# Details of enquiry

Under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act, I should be grateful if you would disclose the number of children referred to the Gender Identity Development Service who have been prescribed puberty blockers each year during the period 2009-2017, together with a breakdown by age and by gender assigned at birth for each year.

# Response Sent

Please note we do not currently hold data on the exact number of those who have been prescribed hormone blockers as we sub contract the endocrinology aspect of GIDS to acute hospital providers.

We do have records of the number of those who we refer to our endocrinology team. While not everyone referred to the endocrinology clinic will be prescribed the hormone blocker, the vast majority will.

The data below show the number of young people referred to our endocrinology clinic. Please note the following fields:

- Year this is the year that the patient was referred to the GIDS, not the year they were referred for endocrinology. This explains why the 2017 data is low.
- Age this is the age at which the young person was referred to the GIDS, not the age they were referred for endocrinology
