The Trust runs are a specialist school for children with complex and severe social, emotional and mental health difficulties, which is called Gloucester House, Tavistock Children's Day Unit. I can confirm that the Trust does not hold any of the requested information on bullying within this school, as does not classify any alleged misdemeanours in terms of biphobic, homophobic and transphobic bullying.

By way of background, Gloucester House is a combined school for education and mental health services, and all the children who join the school will already be presenting with a range of unacceptable social behaviours. We record these behaviours, but not according to any of the categories covered by your questions, and we actively work with these pupils to help them to understand themselves and each other, and to develop awareness and celebration of diversity
