### Response Sent

The Tavistock and Portman NHS Foundation Trust is a specialist mental health Trust which provides outpatient psychotherapy services only. The Trust has no in-patient wards, and the speech and language therapy service is only available at the Gender Identity Clinic in Hammersmith, where a single therapist provides specialised speech therapy to transgender and non-binary service users, in pitch and resonance.

This Trust acquired the Gender Identity Clinic from, WLMHT trust, in April this year, so historical data concerning the provision of this service remains within your own Trust, where you may wish to make further enquiries.
