 - Not applicable. The Tavistock and Portman NHS Foundation Trust is a specialist mental health Trust which provides outpatient psychotherapy services only. The Trust has no inpatient services and does not provide funding for inpatient care.

 - For the period 2015/16 to 2017/18 the primary reason for referral for 382 cases was stated as 'depression/low mood'. We do not hold data electronically on the number of referrals who were/were not at risk of suicide at the time of referral, and to extract this data manually from patient records would require more resources than required by the FOI Act 2000.
