- Whether compensation was paid
- The total amount of compensation paid
- If information available, any action taking following the incident (i.e. additional training, non-slip flooring and so on)

### Response Sent

Since January 2016 The Tavistock and Portman NHS Foundation Trust has incurred one claim, for injury caused by being hit by a wooden object in February 2017. The individual concerned was a Support Worker, employed via an agency. The Trust has challenged the claim, and the outcome is not yet known.

There were no other claims on file covering the last three years.
