- 2. A breakdown of the number of these falls per hospital, by the years above
- 3. A breakdown of the severity of these falls (e.g. low, medium, high)
- 4. The number of patients who were never discharged after their fall i.e. died before discharge.
- 5. Could you break this down both by the years above, and by the hospital where they had the fall.
