The MA Systemic Psychotherapy is 26 months in duration

The data from pre-academic year 2017-18 is held in the QL system or in multiple files within shared drives. The QL system was switched off and archived by the IT Department and there is no access to this data. If this data could be accessed, it would need to be combined and cross-referenced with information from multiple exam board spreadsheets which would take in excess of 18 hours and would be beyond the resources provisioned under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

The course is 26 months and so years 3-4 progression is not possible. We have provided the data for progression from year 1-2.

The data has been collated and anonymised. We have not provided a breakdown by specific ethnic group as this information could lead to the identification of students. We have split the data between all white and all BAME students.
