The GIDS model acknowledges that gender identification is not necessarily fixed, and our psychosocial model reflects that. Transition can mean different things. It may refer to an individual making a social transition and living in a role that reflects their gender identification or in other circumstances it may refer to individuals who wish to consider physical treatment or medical transition. Due to the wide range of pathways young people referred to our service may follow we do not hold percentages of transition by gender assigned at birth.
