 another Trust.

 Not applicable, the Tavistock and Portman NHS Foundation Trust only provides outpatient psychotherapy services within a day clinic environment.
- 3. Is there a specialist Treatment Resistant Depression Pathway within the Trust? The Trust does not diagnose, nor does it have a specific pathway documented for TRD, however we do work with adults suffering this condition as part of an their overall mental health presentation. Decisions as to treatment offered are based on our assessment and delivered at either our Adult Complex Needs Unit and/or our specialist Fitzjohns Unit, where a majority of patients seen were previously under the care of secondary psychiatric services elsewhere, such as a crisis team, a community mental health team (CMHT), a recovery centre, or an eating disorder service.
