I am getting in touch from the Good Law Project - we're a legal campaigning organisation.

We are writing a story about the impact of emergency regulations introducing an immediate ban for trans young people using puberty blockers. The article will look on how Victoria Atkins' intervention could impact the lives of young people.

We would like to give you the opportunity to comment on the following:

- (1) in the seven years leading up to the Bell decision in the Divisional Court one young person on your waiting list died
- (2) in the three years following it 16 did
- (3) that a conscious decision was made by management to withhold that data from minutes - and that senior staff complained about that decision.
